Ford is currently producing the new Shelby GT in response to the Hertz Shelby GT-H.

In 2008, Ford will be producing the Bullitt and the BOSS. The Bullitt will resemble the 1968 390GT driven by Steve McQueen in the movie Bullitt. The new BOSS will be powered by the new 5.0 liter Hurricane V8 powerplant. The BOSS is rumored to produce anywhere from 425-435 HP.

Look for the newly revamped Mustang in 2010 to compete against the new Challenger and Camaro.

Ford dealerships around the country in the month of December bid on 113 Shelby GT-H's available from Hertz. Some of these vehicles will be available for sale.

Ford has just announced a four door concept car called the Interceptor that will be carrying most of the Mustang's mechanical underpinnings.
